Correct any problems found. If the patient has no pulse, begin CPR.	1		(CPI)

Call for help and arrange for transport that includes ALS.	1		
Monitor the airway and administer high-flow oxygen.	1		
To prevent heat loss, keep the patient warm and dry.	1
