With disposable gloves on, remove one tablet from the bottle and place the tablet in the patient's hand. If using nitroglycerin sublingual spray, do NOT shake the metered-dose spray.	1		
Instruct the patient to place the medication under the tongue and allow it to dissolve completely. Tell the patient not to chew or swallow the tablet. If necessary, assist the patient by instructing to lift their tongue and place the medication in place. If using nitroglycerin sublingual spray, assist patient in applying one spray beneath the patient's tongue.	1
