Firmly support the patient as you lower the person to the ground or onto a backboard.	1		
Secure the patient with the right arm over the head and the left arm along the torso.	1		
Tie the patient down completely, using as many straps as needed; be prepared to tilt the board if the patient should vomit.	1
